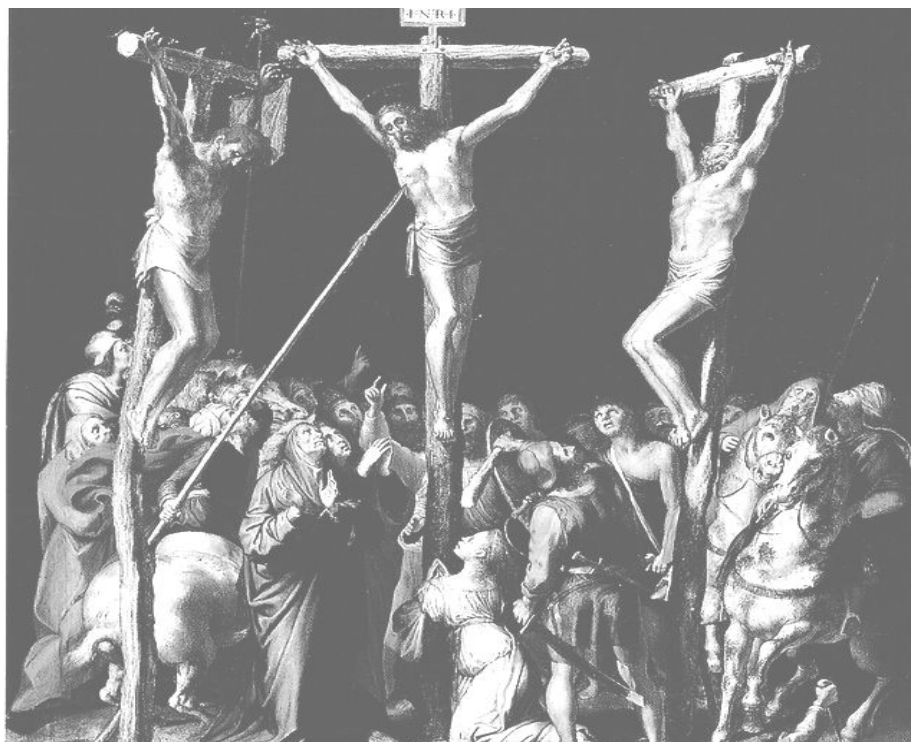
Adoramus te, Christe
